INTRODUCTION

Welcome to Equestrian Village ("Equestrian Village," "we," "our," or "us").

These Terms and Conditions ("Terms") govern your access to and use of the Equestrian Village website, mobile applications, digital publications, educational resources, online services, events, donations, merchandise, and all related online platforms (collectively, the "Website" or the "Services").

By accessing or using the Website, you acknowledge that you have read, understood, and agree to be legally bound by these Terms and all applicable federal, state, and local laws.

If you do not agree to these Terms, you should discontinue use of the Website immediately.

The Foundational Principles, Vision Statement, Mission Statement, Statement of Faith, and other ministry documents published by Equestrian Village describe the ministry's religious beliefs and guiding philosophy. Those documents are separate from these Terms and Conditions and do not modify the legal rights and obligations established herein except where expressly incorporated by reference.

ARTICLE I

ACCEPTANCE OF TERMS

By accessing or using this Website, you represent and warrant that:

- you are at least eighteen (18) years of age, or are using the Website under the supervision of a parent or legal guardian;
- you possess the legal authority to enter into these Terms;
- your use of the Website complies with applicable law;
- you agree to comply with these Terms and any future revisions published by Equestrian Village.

These Terms constitute a legally binding agreement between you and Equestrian Village.

ARTICLE II

DEFINITIONS

For purposes of these Terms:

"Website" means all internet domains, subdomains, mobile applications, digital platforms, social media accounts, and online resources owned or operated by Equestrian Village.

"Content" means all original works appearing on the Website, including text, articles, devotionals, mission statements, educational curriculum, Bible studies, sermons, podcasts, videos, photographs, graphics, illustrations, logos, trademarks, service marks, software, downloadable materials, databases, and compilations.

"User" means every visitor, member, donor, volunteer, subscriber, customer, or person accessing the Website.

"Services" means all ministry activities provided through the Website, including educational resources, charitable programs, online events, publications, merchandise, donations, memberships, and communications.

ARTICLE III

Nothing contained on this Website shall be construed as creating any fiduciary, professional, pastoral, legal, medical, counseling, financial, or other professional relationship except where expressly stated in writing.

ARTICLE IV

INTELLECTUAL PROPERTY RIGHTS

4.1 Ownership

Unless otherwise indicated, all original literary works, compilations, ministry publications, educational materials, curriculum, devotionals, sermons, podcasts, videos, graphics, logos, photographs, website design, databases, downloadable resources, and other original creative works appearing on this Website—including the *Foundational Principles of Equestrian Village*—are owned by Equestrian Village or its licensors and are protected under United States copyright law and other applicable intellectual property laws.

4.2 Scripture Quotations

Scripture references and quotations appearing on this Website are included for devotional, educational, and ministry purposes.

10.2 User Representations

unless a greater recovery is required by applicable law.

17.4 Indemnification

Federal law shall govern where applicable.

19.2 Venue

Unless otherwise required by applicable law or agreed in writing, any legal action arising from these Terms shall be brought exclusively in the state or federal courts located within the Commonwealth of Virginia.

Each party consents to the personal jurisdiction of those courts.

19.3 Statute of Limitations

To the extent permitted by applicable law, any claim arising out of these Terms or the use of the Website must be commenced within one (1) year after the claim accrues. If a shorter limitations period is prohibited by law, the applicable statutory period shall govern.

ARTICLE XX

DISPUTE RESOLUTION

20.1 Good-Faith Resolution

Before initiating litigation, the parties are encouraged to make reasonable, good-faith efforts to resolve disputes through informal communication.

Nothing in this section prevents either party from seeking temporary or preliminary injunctive relief where immediate action is reasonably necessary to protect intellectual property rights, confidential information, or other legal rights.

20.2 Optional Mediation

If a dispute cannot be resolved informally, the parties are encouraged—but not required—to participate in non-binding mediation before a mutually agreed-upon mediator located in Virginia.

Unless otherwise agreed, each party shall bear its own costs, and the parties shall share the mediator's fees equally.

20.3 Litigation

If mediation is unsuccessful or not pursued, either party may seek relief in a court of competent jurisdiction as provided in Article XX.

20.4 Injunctive Relief

Because unauthorized use of Equestrian Village's intellectual property may cause irreparable harm that cannot be adequately remedied by monetary damages alone, Equestrian Village may

seek temporary, preliminary, or permanent injunctive relief, specific performance, or other equitable remedies, in addition to any other remedies available under applicable law.

ARTICLE XXII

SEVERABILITY AND WAIVER

22.1 Severability

If any provision of these Terms is determined by a court of competent jurisdiction to be invalid, illegal, or unenforceable, that provision shall be enforced to the maximum extent permitted by applicable law, and the remaining provisions shall remain in full force and effect.

22.2 Waiver

No failure or delay by Equestrian Village in exercising any right or remedy under these Terms shall constitute a waiver of that right or remedy.

A waiver shall be effective only if made in writing and signed by an authorized representative of Equestrian Village.

22.3 Entire Agreement

These Terms, together with the Privacy Policy and any additional policies expressly incorporated by reference, constitute the entire agreement between the User and Equestrian Village regarding the Website and supersede all prior or contemporaneous communications, representations, or agreements relating to the Website.

ARTICLE XXIII

CHANGES TO THESE TERMS

23.1 Right to Modify
